Work of the Handmaids: Education




- The Handmaid Sisters run two nursery schools in Bazartete and Fahilebo.
- The children in grades one to four go to school for about two hours each day.
- The Primary School in Bazartete, like many others, was destroyed during the country's war for independence from Indonesia.





Building a Nation

- East Timor is not a developed country and there is a lot of poverty.
- The country faces challenges in building infrastructure.
- Young people have problems finding jobs. Nearly half of the population is under age 15.
- About 49% of children under age five are underweight and below the standard of height for their age.

- In 2015, they started a rabbit pen and learned how to breed them
